

### Grade 000, Grade 00 and Grade R - 2023

Montrose Pre-Primary School is a Private Early Childhood Development Service and does not receive financial support from the Education Department.

While closely associated with Montrose Primary School, it should however be noted that acceptance and enrolment at Montrose Pre-Primary does in no way guarantee admission to Montrose Primary School. Admission requirements will have to be met to ensure enrolment at Montrose Primary School.

We offer Grade R classes that cater for learners entering into Grade 1 the following year, Grade 00 classes and Grade 000 classes.

Our fully qualified teachers feel that it is a privilege to share the learning experiences of small children. The classroom is a home away from home. Each day is planned so that there are numerous opportunities for individual attention and for participation in group activities. The learning experiences are presented through thematic teaching throughout the year and we value and encourage parental support.

Learners are challenged to become responsible, independent, creative and innovative. In addition to our own facilities, our learners make use of the Montrose Primary School facilities, such as the sports facilities.

School hours are from 07h45 to 12h45 for the Grade R's, 08h00 to 12h30 for the Grade 00 and 08h00 to 12h00 for the Grade 000. Learners may be dropped off from 07h15. The school provides a snack (sandwiches and fruit/veggies) during the morning (10h00). Cooked lunch and an afternoon snack are provided to aftercare learners.

All learners are required to wear a Montrose hat during break time and outside activities. A Montrose T-shirt is required to be worn on outings and special occasions.

#### School Fees 2023 (4 terms)

- **Option One** - One (1) payment of R58 000 (Fifty-eight thousand rand) to be received before 31 January 2023. A discount of R3 000 given for early settlement. No discounts will be granted thereafter.
- **Option Two** - January to October 2023 - Ten (10) payments of R6 100 (six thousand one hundred rand) paid monthly from January to October 2023. The first payment is due prior to the first school day i.e. Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2023. Subsequent payments to be paid before the 1<sup>st</sup> of February, and then before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each subsequent month.

We charge a comprehensive school fee, which in addition to the normal activities, covers the following activities, which take place during the school hours:

- Swimming lessons (heated pool)
- Physical education, and gross motor training
- Music
- isiZulu
- Library
- I Pads (Grade R's only)

Also included in the fees:

- Stationery, toiletries, hat, t-shirt
- Shows during the school term
- School Photographs
- Eye and Hearing Screening for the Children

The following are NOT included in the fees:

- Aftercare
- Private extra-curricular activities, which include:
  - Ballet
  - Cricket
  - Netball
  - Soccer
- Therapist's fees - the following of which are currently available on site during the school day:
  - Speech
  - Occupational
  - Counselling Psychologist / Play Therapist

A once off non-refundable Admission Fee of R500.00 is due upon application, and a non-refundable Capital Levy of R2 500.00 is paid upon acceptance (annually).

A full term's written notice is required in advance when leaving the school or three months fees in lieu of notice.
