## Grade 0000, 000, Grade 00 and Grade R

Montrose Pre-Primary School is a Private Early Childhood Development Service and does not receive financial support from the Education Department.

While closely associated with Montrose Primary School, it should however be noted that acceptance and enrolment at Montrose Pre-Primary does in no way guarantee admission to Montrose Primary School. Admission requirements will have to be met to ensure enrolment at Montrose Primary School.

We offer Grade R classes that cater for learners entering into Grade 1 the following year, and Grade 00, Grade 000 and Grade 0000 classes.

Our fully qualified teachers feel that it is a privilege to share the learning experiences of small children. The classroom is a home away from home. Each day is planned so that there are numerous opportunities for individual attention and for participation in group activities. The learning experiences are presented through thematic teaching throughout the year and we value and encourage parental support.

Learners are challenged to become responsible, independent, creative and innovative. In addition to our own facilities, our learners make use of the Montrose Primary School facilities, such as the sports facilities.

School hours are from 07h45 - 12h45 for the Grade R's, 08h00 - 12h30 for Grade 00 and 08h00 - 12h00 for Grade 000. Learners may be dropped off from 07h15. The school provides a snack (sandwiches and fruit/veggies) during the morning (10h00). Cooked lunch and an afternoon snack are provided to aftercare learners.

All learners are required to wear a Montrose hat during break time and outside activities. A Montrose T-shirt is required to be worn on special occasions.

## School Fees 2026 (4 terms) - R70 800 (seventy thousand eight hundred rand)

- Option One One (1) payment of R67 200 (Sixty-seven thousand two hundred rand) to be received before 31 January 2026. A discount given for early settlement. No discounts will be granted thereafter.
- Option Two Ten (10) monthly payments of R7 080 (seven thousand and eighty rand) paid January to October 2026. The first payment is due prior to the first school day i.e. Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2026. Subsequent payments to be paid before the 1<sup>st</sup> of February, and then by the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each subsequent month.

**Please note:** Regardless of which option is chosen, when you accept a position at the school you are committing to the full year's school fees. Should your child need to

leave the school mid-year, one full term's notice is required in writing, and fees will be due and payable up to the end of that notice period.

We charge a comprehensive school fee, which in addition to the normal activities, covers the following activities, which take place during the school hours:

- Swimming lessons (heated pool)
- o Physical education, and gross motor training
- o Music
- o isiZulu
- Library
- o iPads (Grade R's only)

## Also included in the fees:

- o Start-of-the-year stationery, toiletries, hat, t-shirt
- Shows during the school term
- School Photographs
- Eye and Hearing Screening for the Children

The following are NOT included in the fees:

- Aftercare
- o Private extra-curricular activities, which include:
  - Ballet
  - Cricket
  - Drama
  - Gardenina
  - Netball
  - Soccer
- Therapist's fees the following of which are currently available on site during the school day:
  - Speech
  - Occupational
  - Counselling Psychologist / Play Therapist

A once off non-refundable Admission Fee of R500.00 is due upon application, and a non-refundable Capital Levy of R2 500.00 is paid upon acceptance (and annually).
